Notice: Nominations will open on August 26, 2011 and will remain open for 25 days. Nominations shall close on September 19, 2011 immediately preceding voting. "All members shall be given at least fifteen (15) days advance notice, in writing, of the date, time and place at which nominations shall be made, and the date, time and place at which elections shall be held." This memo will serve as such notice, posted on the bulletin boards, published on www.LafayetteFirefighters.com, and emailed to all members who have submitted their address to the President via Union619@cox.net.

Procedure: Nominations shall be in writing and given to the Secretary/Treasurer or emailed to the President via Union619@cox.net. Late, lost, or misdirected nominations will not be accepted after the close of nominations on September 19, 2011.

Candidates: Any member in good standing may be nominated. Nominations will be validated immediately preceding voting by satisfying the "Regular Nominations" section of the Constitution and By-Laws.

Regular Nominations: "Only members who have attended at least four (4) regular meetings during the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the opening date of nominations shall be eligible as candidates for office."

Voting: Voting will be conducted on September 19 & 21, 2011 during the Union meetings. Tabulation of all ballots shall be conducted as the last order of business at the close of the September 21, Union Meeting by the election committee. "Each candidate for office shall be entitled to appoint one (1) observer who shall be permitted to witness the manner of distribution and casting of ballots and attend the meeting of the committee at which the votes are tabulated".

"All newly elected officers shall assume their duties of office immediately preceding the next regular union meeting following their election."
